BUST THE BLOCK has 3 main goals:

1. Health Promotion

Every child at Rosanna Primary School will be involved in walking around the school block. It is a great way to promote healthy fun and activity.

2. To hold an event which is a celebration of the houses at Rosanna Primary School: Green Grevillea, Red Waratah, Blue Gum and Golden Wattle.

Children can dress up in house colours on the day. Points for their house are earned according to how many laps they walk. The house which earns the most points will be acknowledged as the winners of the Bust the Block Walk-a-thon.

3. Fundraising

Children are asked to seek sponsorship money prior to the walk-a-thon (either per lap pledges or lump sum donations). All money is to be handed in 1 week after the walk-a-thon, by **Wednesday 14 September 2016**.

PRIZES

One child from each year level who walks the most laps will win a prize. If there are a number of children with an equal number of laps they will each win a prize. There will also be a prize for the child who raises the most money.

RULES

1. Preps to grade 2 will walk a shorter modified course (see map).
2. Grade 3 to 6 will walk the school block, avoiding Davies St and using the gates to walk through the school (see map) and exiting Davies St.
3. At the completion of each lap, a walk-a-thon volunteer or teacher will mark each child's card to indicate their number of laps.
4. At the end of the designated time, children are to return to their class room. A walk-a-thon volunteer or teacher will add up their laps and write it on their sponsorship form and sign it off.
